Thus, it is key that sports managers can have the tools and skills needed to ensure a proper maintenance of grass sports fields. In this way, this course will give you the leading tools to lawn maintenance effectiveness. This will have not only financial implications in both revenues and expenses, but also a direct impact on the development of shows and the sports activity. This means that, in many cases, the planning and strategy of the team's technical and tactical work will be affected because, for example, decisions can be taken to make the field slower or faster for the game, to reduce the probability of injuries, or to maximise a specific training session.
